(REDETERMINATION OF MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE ORDER 202-

The East Ayrshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on then by sections 1(1) and 152 (2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling then in that behalf, hereby make the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as *East Ayrshire Council (C24 Bonnyton Road, Kilmarnock) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage Order 202-* and shall come into operation on the xx day of xxx 202-.
2. The road in the area of Kilmarnock specified in the Schedule to this order, at present a carriageway shall become a cycle track the right of passage being exercisable on pedal cycle and foot only.
