South Ayrshire Council, ("the Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 1, 81 to 85, as amended, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "South Ayrshire Council (Daily Primary School, Daily) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2003," and shall come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 2003.
2. That the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 (1) and (2) of the Act, which reduces the speed limit on a restricted road.

This Order together with the Schedule annexed and signed as relative hereto are subscribed for and behalf of South Ayrshire Council by Daniel Chapman Russell (subscribing his usual signature "Dan Russell"), Head of Legal and Administration at Ayr on the Twenty seventh day of January, in the year Two Thousand and three before this witness Eleanor Jane McLaren 9subscribing her usual signature "E. McLaren"), Solicitor, County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr.

### Lengths of Road within South Ayrshire

1. That length of Main Street, Dailly (Unclassified), from the extended northeast kerbline of Bridge Street, Dailly northeastwards to a point 55 metres southwest of the extended southwest kerbline of Greenhead Street, Dailly a distance of 262 metres or thereby.
