**NOTICE OF MAKING**

Notice is hereby given that on 17/12/20 the Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic Act 1991, The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and of all other enabling powers introducing the following waiting and loading restrictions as part of the new Ayr Grammar development:-

**No Waiting At Any Time No Loading / Unloading  
8:30am-9:15am and 2.30pm-3:45pm Monday – Friday**

**Fort Street** – east side: from 22 metres southwest of the outer circumference of the mini roundabout at South Harbour Street, south-westwards for 15 metres. **Fort Street** – east side: from the northernmost kerblines of Academy Street adjacent to the parking bays, southwards for 18 metres. **Fort Street** – west side: from the outer circumference of the mini roundabout at South Harbour Street, south-westwards for 35 metres.

**Waiting Limited to 30 Minutes 8:00am-6:00pm Monday – Saturday  
Return Prohibited within 1 hour**

**Fort Street** – west side: from 3 metres north of a point opposite of Cathcart Street, northwards for 44 metres.

**Waiting Limited to 3 Hours 8:00am-6:00pm Monday – Saturday  
Return Prohibited within 1 hour**

**South Harbour Street** – south side: from 28 metres west of Fort Street, westwards for 44 metres.

**Disabled Persons' Vehicles Designated Parking Places  
Waiting Limited to 2 Hours**

**Fort Street** – west side: from 77 metres north of a point opposite of Cathcart Street, northwards for 12 metres.

The Order which comes into force on 04/01/2021 was previously advertised in the Ayrshire Post on 23/09/20 and the effect of the Order is as stated in that notice.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act), the Road Traffic Act 1991, The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Acts, or of any other instrument made under the 1984 Act, has not been complied with in relation to this Order may, within six weeks from 17/12/20 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
