



**SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL  
(Town of Ayr) (Waiting Restrictions)  
(Consolidation) Order 2015**

South Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 99, 101, 102, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the "South Ayrshire Council (Town of Ayr) (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2015.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"the 1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the 1991 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"bus" means -

- (i) a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers (exclusive of the driver);
- (ii) a local bus not so constructed or adapted;

"Council" means South Ayrshire Council – County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr KA7 1DR;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons ('badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000, as amended;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"universal postal service" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, whether or not by mechanical power;

3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of Waiting and Loading at specified times (Schedules 4 – 14)

18. Save as provided in Articles 26, 27 and 28 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedules 11, 12 and 13 to this Order.

1. From a point 37 metres or thereby west of the west kerbline of Earls Way Roundabout to a point 18 metres east of the east kerbline of Earls Way Roundabout.
2. From a point 18 metres west of the extended west kerbline of Kilbrandon Crescent to a point 18 metres east of the extended east kerbline of Kilbrandon Crescent.

From the extended south kerbline of Abbots Way southwards for a distance of 12 metres.
