(Esplanade, Ayr)
(Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2021

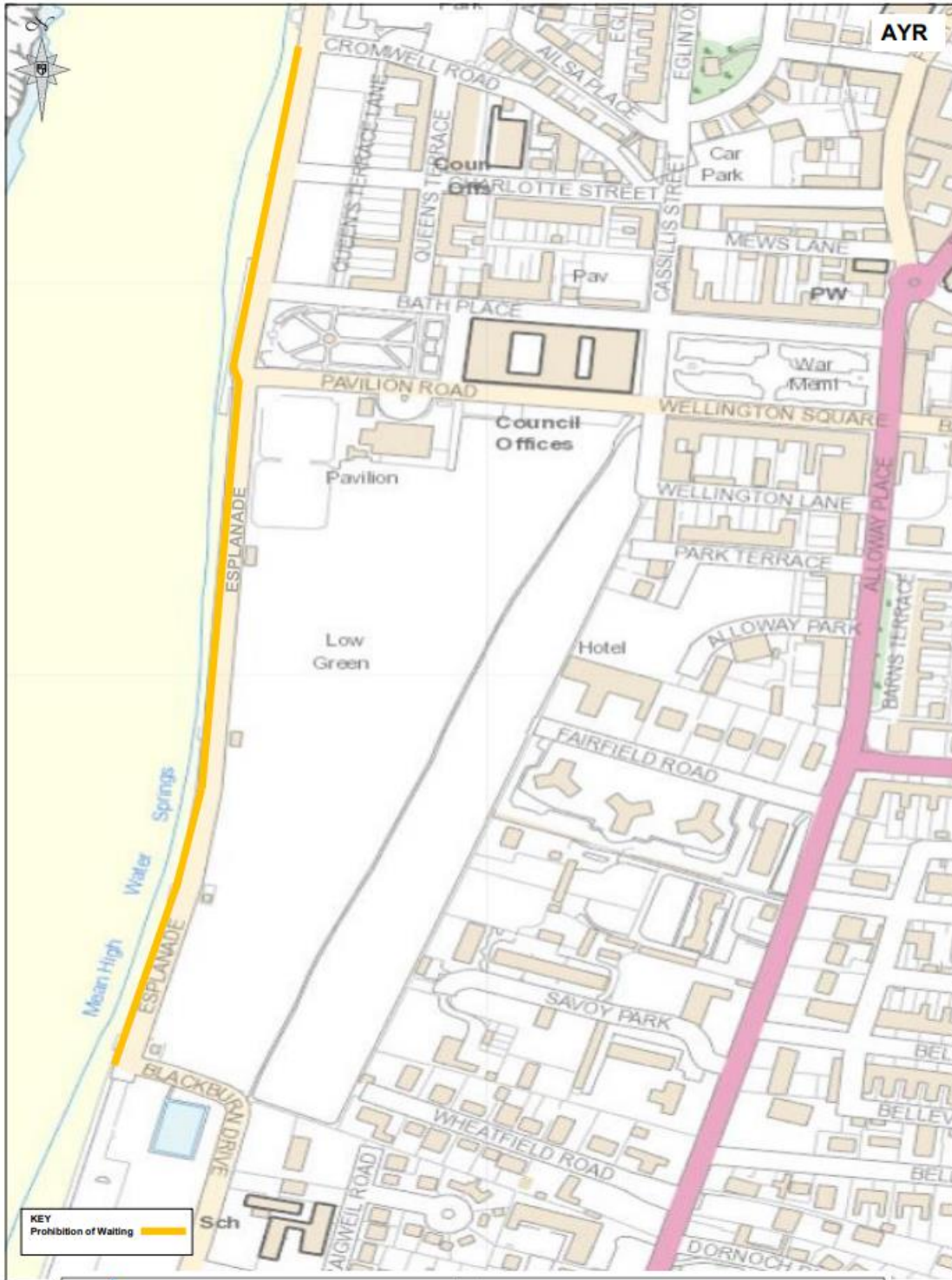
On 23/12/21 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order which will make it unlawful for any vehicle to wait at any time on the following lengths of road:-

Esplanade - West Side: Between Cromwell Road and Blackburn Drive;

This is to allow contractors access to resurface the adjacent footways.

This Order is in force from 00:01hrs on Wednesday 5th January. To minimise inconvenience the footway resurfacing and waiting restrictions will be carried out in phases. Restrictions are expected to remain in place until anticipated completion by Monday 28th February 2022 or for so long as the appropriate road markings / signs are in place, whichever is sooner.
