

South Ayrshire Council
(U27 Deils Elbow, North / South Balloch)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

On 23/12/21 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, by reason of works to be undertaken on or near the road for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will make it unlawful for any person to drive, cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the U27 Deils Elbow that runs from North / South Balloch to the B741 just east of Cloyntie.

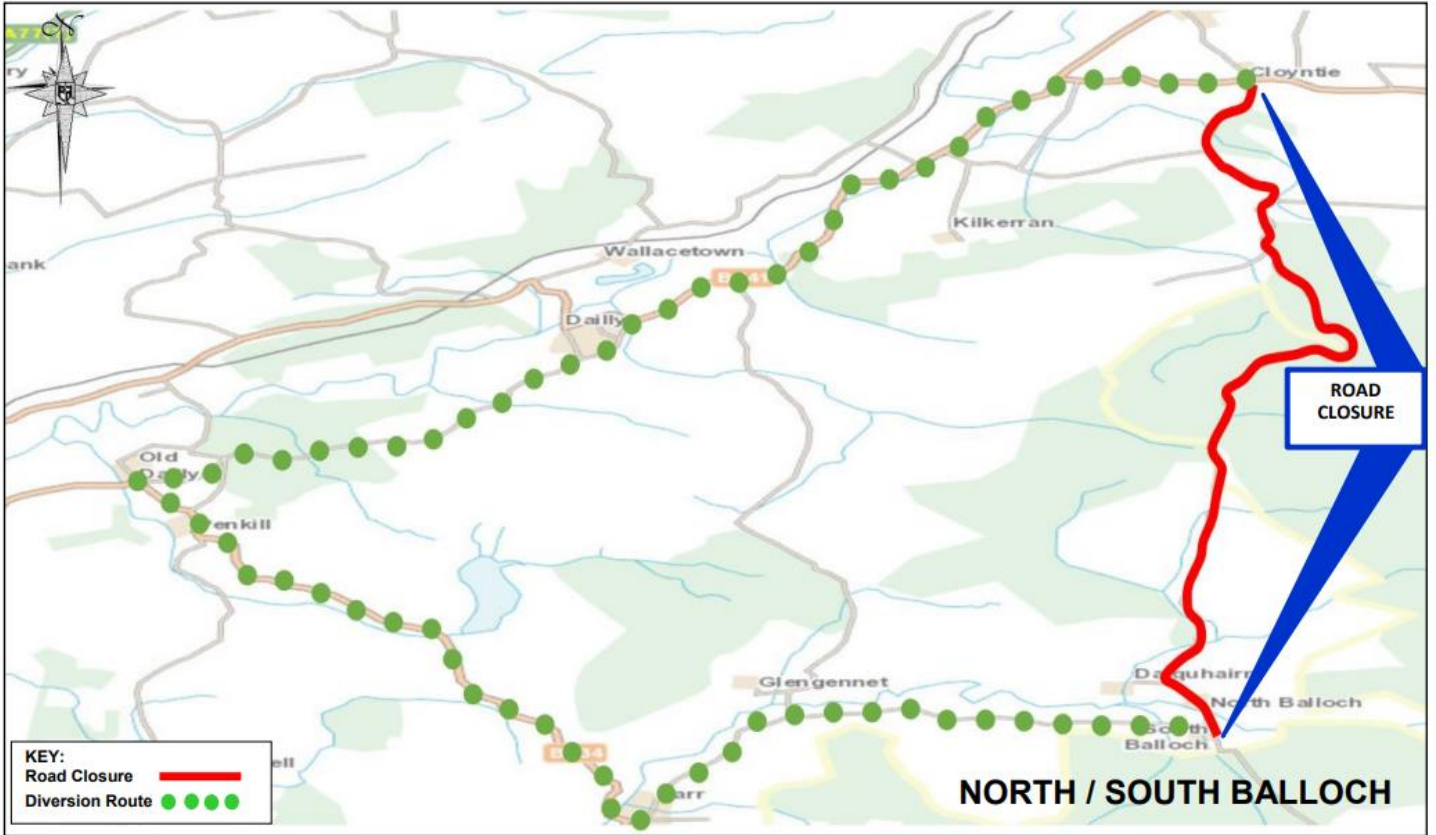
The Order is in force from 08:00 hours on Monday 17th January. To minimise inconvenience, the road is expected to only be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 hours each day with it being open out-with these times until anticipated completion by 17:00 hours on Friday 28th January 2022. The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services vehicles will not be affected and access for any residents and pedestrians out-with the working zone will be maintained. An alternative route suitable for all through traffic will be signed via the B741 Dailly/Straiton – C151 Woodside Dailly – B7035 Dailly/Old Dailly – B734 Old Dailly/Barr – Stinchar Road, Barr – Glenginnet Road, Barr – U66 to South Balloch in both directions.
