

South Ayrshire Council
(Kirklandhill Path, Maybole)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2021

On 03/06/2021 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, by reason of the construction of a new over-bridge for the Maybole Bypass and associated works in Kirklandhill Path.

The Order will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the following lengths of road, Kirklandhill Path from 400 metres northwest of Cargill Road, northwards for approximately 320 metres; or to wait in Kirklandhill Path, from Cargill Road, northwards to a point just north of Ashgrove Lane, a distance of approximately 195 metres and follows the issuing of Temporary Notices under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Act 1984, as amended.

It is necessary for the restrictions to remain in place to maintain a safe access from the Cargill Road end of Kirklandhill Path by the emergency services if required and for deliveries to all properties including those in Ashgrove Lane due to the narrowness of the road that would otherwise prevent access by any class of vehicle.

Pedestrian and non-motorised vehicle users will not be affected by the road closure and vehicular access for the emergency services and to properties will be maintained. A diversion route suitable for through traffic will be signed via the Cargill Road, B7023 Culzean Road and the C60 Ladycross Road to Kirklandhill Path in both directions. Local access via Gardenrose Path will not be affected.

The Order is in force from 10/06/2021 with anticipated completion of the works by 31/10/2021. The Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.
