

South Ayrshire Council
(U98 Main Street / Townend Road, Symington)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

On 22/07/21 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, by reason of works to be undertaken on or near the road for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will make it unlawful for any person to drive, cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the U98 Main Street / Townend Road, Symington, from the C34 Symington Road North / Symington Road South, north-eastwards to the junction with Townend Terrace / Townend Brae, a distance of approximately 620 metres.

The Order is in force from 08:00 hours on Monday 2nd August. To minimise inconvenience, the road is expected to only be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 hours each day with it being open out-with these times until anticipated completion by 17:00 hours on Monday 23rd August 2021. The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services vehicles will not be affected and access for any residents and pedestrians out-with the working zone will be maintained. An alternative route suitable for all through traffic will be signed via Symington Road South to A77 South West slip road, A77 - Dutch House roundabout - A78 Monktonhead roundabout - B746 slip road – roundabout - Corraith Road to Townend Road in both directions.
