

South Ayrshire Council
(Dunlop Terrace, Maybole)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

On 23/09/21 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, by reason of works to be undertaken by Scottish Water for water main renewals.

The Order will make it unlawful for any person to drive, cause or permit to be driven on Welltrees Street to enter Dunlop Terrace by way of closure at the junction of Welltrees Street.

The Order is in force from 00:01 hours on Thursday 30th September until anticipated completion by 23:59 hours on Tuesday 21st October 2021. The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

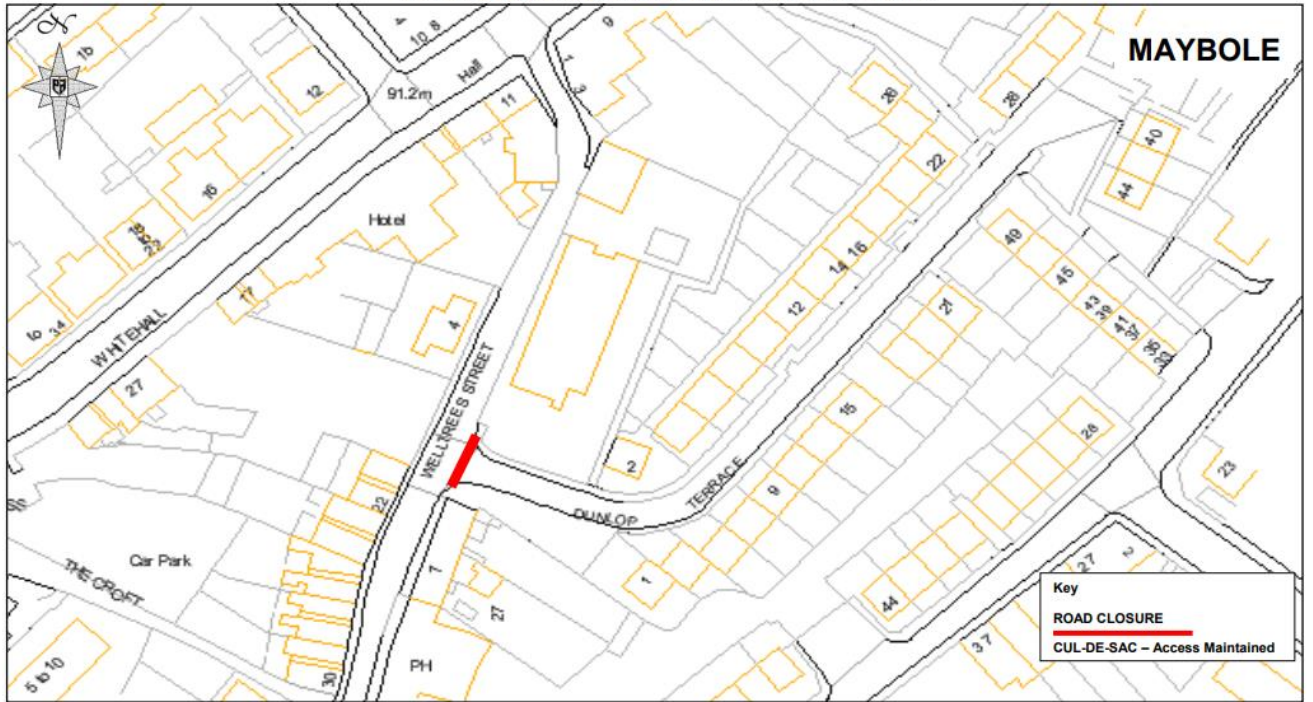
Access for the Emergency Services and pedestrians will be maintained. As Dunlop Terrace is a cul-de-sac, there is no alternative route so access for residents, to properties and for deliveries will be maintained whenever possible, but may be restricted at times.
